Due to the Covid 19 Pandemic, the 2020 Woodlawn Mini Lobster Six Wicket USCA Sanctioned Croquet Tournament will be a low key event this year but the spirited croquet competition will remain the same as in the past. This format will keep the entry fee reasonable and still provide a little income for the maintenance of our facility. Based on that, we will not have our usual opening reception and dinner and we ask that players provide their own lunches and snacks daily. The handling of food is difficult to comply with all the guidelines involved. We have plenty of open space to provide for social distancing and the ability to make it safe for our players and spectators. Any equipment being used will be sanitized before each match begins. Players coming from out of the State of Maine must comply with the Maine CDC guidelines which can be found at home/Covid-19-Maine.gov.

Courts will be open for practice on Wednesday Afternoon, September 9. A meeting to distribute the schedules and handle any questions will be held at 5:30 PM at the Woodlawn Croquet court. Play will commence on Thursday morning, September 10 and end with the championship games on Sunday, September 13. Lobster rolls will be provided on Sunday at noontime during the championship games.
